

# **Mission Commander Responsibilities Briefing**

As the Mission Commander, you are responsible for overseeing a smooth, timely, and effective execution of the mission. Please review and adhere to the following responsibilities and tasks:

## **Pre-Mission Requirements**

- Ensure Mission Upload: Confirm the mission is correctly loaded and running on VCAW-99's server prior to briefing.
- **Timely Start:** Ensure the mission starts on schedule, coordinating closely with all flights to avoid delays.

# **In-Flight Responsibilities**

- **Coordinate Flight Launches:** Oversee and facilitate flight launches, ensuring all assigned aircraft are airborne promptly and following designated flight paths.
- **Mission Direction:** Provide clear, real-time mission directions to all flights as needed, adapting to situational changes or challenges that may arise.
- Inter-Flight Timing: Ensure flights return to base within 10 minutes of each other to maintain mission flow and debriefing efficiency.

### **Post-Mission Handoff**

• End of Responsibility: The Mission Commander's responsibilities conclude once flights have landed and recovered aboard the USS Truman. Confirm all relevant mission data is recorded and prepared for debrief.

## **Additional Notes**

- **Communication:** Be prepared to relay critical updates and maintain situational awareness across all communications channels.
- **Debrief Preparation:** Coordinate with training staff for post-flight debrief to evaluate mission performance and discuss lessons learned.
